The California Trails Users Coalition (CTUC), a nonprofit organization, In cooperation with the Department of Interior's Bureau of Land Management, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Angeles National Forest, San Bernardino National Forest, Sequoia National Forest, Sierra National Forest and Los Padres National Forest, the CTUC has undertaken steps to improve upon lands in Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Venture, Fresno, Madera, and Mariposa Counties, by submitting grants for these enhancements.

All Agencies and the CTUC would like to invite you to review and comment on the 2010 applications we have submitted to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division (OHMVR). The public review and comment period will be open from **Tuesday, March 2 through Monday, April 5.**

The OHV grant applications are an annual process that play a key roll in the success of CTUC being able to bring you a safe and a quality place to recreate. The California Department of Parks and Recreation, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division (OHMVR)which issues grants to a variety of entities to improve or mitigate off-highway vehicle (OHV) recreation. Under this process, the CTUC applies for grants from the state each year to help fund and coordinate its OHV program.
